

NATIONAL DO NOT CALL REGISTRY

COMPLAINT CHECKLIST

The National Do Not Call Registry gives you a choice about getting telemarketing calls at home. Once your number has been on the National Do Not Call Registry for three months, most telemarketing calls will stop. But not all.

Still allowed:

- Calls from — or on behalf of — political organizations, charities, and telephone surveyors.
- Calls from companies with which you have an existing business relationship. (A company may call you for 18 months after you make a purchase or three months after you submit an inquiry or application.)
- Calls from companies you've given written permission to call.

If a telemarketer calls a number that's been on the registry for at least three months, you can complain. Visit DONOTCALL.GOV or call 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236). To file a complaint, you'll need the date of the call and the phone number or the name of the company that called you. If you get telemarketing calls that aren't allowed, use the forms on this page to record information and let us know.
