Plaintiff, the United States of America, acting upon notification and authorization to the Attorney General by the Federal Trade Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to Section 16(a)(1) of the Federal Trade Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 56(a)(1), for its complaint alleges that:

1. Plaintiff brings this action under Sections 5(a)(1), 5(m)(1)(A), 13(b), and 19 of the Federal Trade Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. §§ 45(a)(1), 45(m)(1)(A), 53(b), and 57b, to secure civil penalties, permanent injunctive relief, consumer redress, and other equitable relief for defendant's violations of the Commission's Trade Regulation Rule entitled "Disclosure Requirements and Prohibitions Concerning Franchising and Business

FTC Act, including but not limited to, the rescission of contracts, the refund of monies paid, and the disgorgement of ill-gotten monies; and,

(6) Award plaintiff the costs of bringing this action, as well as such other and additional relief as the Court may determine to be just and proper.


