

To Whom It May Concern:

In addition to the 8 items outlined in Section 315.2 "Definitions" dealing specifically with "Contact Lens Prescription," I believe two more items should be included in the definition. These two items are:

- 1) the total number of lenses that can be ordered under the life of the prescription, and
- 2) the instructions for use of the contact lenses (e.g., daily wear, replace monthly, etc.)

As with any prescription for legend drugs, the quantity and instructions for use should be included along with the specifications of the particular product that allows the seller to dispense the proper item.
