I have also had the experience of having my eye doctor sigh heavily when I asked for a contact lens prescription.

I do not understand why the FTC is trying to pass this law to make consumers wait to purchase lenses. Could you explain more fully? While I do appreciate the Fairness Act which forces the doctor to give the prescription at no charge, I do not understand the waiting period.
