Please pass the law of Contact lends Law, because I believe we contact wearer have rights to use the prescription of contact lends to whomever we think it is appropriate to purchase from. It is important to me that it be as easy and convenient as possible to purchase my lenses from whomever I choose. I am a single and full-time working mother with no personal time every single day. I have no time to go back and forth to the doctor's office to my eye examines and order contact lends and pick up after the arrival. Usually I have to call in to doctor's office first to get an appointment for the prescription to be ready.

I do believe that Doctor has to prepare the prescription for patients at first. That is really important. But after the prescription is issued, patients have rights to use it wherever it is appropriate for them to purchase lends. However, the seller of the lends has to be licensed, and lends must be inspected under the Federal Law.
