I oppose that part of the proposed rule which could force me to wait days for my contact lenses. I urge you not to limit my rights, as a contact lens wearer. Please note, for the public record, that as a contact lens consumer, I do not wish for my rights to be limited. It is very important for me to have the freedom to obtain my lenses quickly and easily. We have a child that has survived a brain tumor, and still requires intensive assistance, so, waiting days for my lenses could pose a major obstacle to me and my family because I need my lenses to function. The capability of having next day service should not be taken from me, and the purchase of my lenses from 1-800-CONTACTS has provided me an excellent alternative source for purchasing contact lenses quickly and easily.
