I'm writing about the proposed rule which will make contact lense wearers wait days to receive their lenses. Please oppose this section of the proposed rule.

I have worn contact lenses for over 30 years. I live in a rural part of Michigan and work full time. It has been extremely convenient for me to order my lenses by phone/internet. They are shipped the same day, and arrive only 1 or 2 days later. This is much faster than waiting the two weeks I would have to wait if I ordered from my eye doctor, and I don't have to pick them up which also saves me about 1 1/2 hours of driving time.

I hate to admit it, but being only human I sometimes wait until I am on my very last pair before ordering more. It has been great to be able to have new contacts arrive in just a day or so.
