To Whom It May Concern:

I recently received notice that the Federal Trade Commission is trying to implement a new rule that could make it more difficult to receive my contact lens the next day.

I have been using 1-800-Contacts for several years now and have always found their service simple and convenient to use. For a busy professional like myself, it is much easier to go to my computer and order contact lenses than having to go to my local eye doctor who is only open Monday - Friday until 6 p.m. and limited hours on Saturday.

At times I often don't realize it is time to order new contact lenses until I am on my last pair. This makes next day service very important as I could easily lose a contact and be left without a pair for two or three days. I do have a pair of glasses but am much more comfortable while wearing my contact lenses.

Thus it is important that I continue to receive the fast and convenient service that 1-800-Contacts has provided to me over the past few years, and I am writing to document my opposition to the new rule. I hope that you will take this into consideration as you move forward with your decision.
