Dear FTC -

This note is to voice a concern regarding the proposed waiting period for contact lens order fulfillment.

As someone who travels for long periods, it is important that I be able to order and receive contact lenses while on the road. The difficulty of a waiting period, or a requirement for a local ophthalmologist to manage fulfillment represents an unnecessary delay and expense. It may perhaps help the special interest of the medical community, but it does not support and protect the consumer.

Frankly, not being able to get overnight fulfillment can present a danger for someone like myself who relies on contact lenses to see, especially during travel when luggage is lost or stolen.
